Exploration Update

Since listing The Company has focused on identifying a number of drill targets at its Randall's and Kalgoorlie West Projects. The targets were identified after a review of previous rotary air blast and reverse circulation drilling results and from the results of a structural geological and mineral alteration study based on Landsat data.

Field checking is being carried out to help prioritize the targets before commencing a RAB / light RC drilling program to evaluate them. A drilling has been appointed and is available to commence the drill program once we have received DOIR approvals, which is expected mid to late February 2008.
