Commencement of Mining.

The Directors of Nex Metals Explorations Ltd (the Company or Nex) are pleased to advise that mining has commenced at the Butterfly Pit as part of the Kookynie Gold Project.

The Directors of Nex Metals Explorations Ltd (the Company or Nex) are pleased to advise that mining has commenced at the Butterfly Pit as part of the Kookynie Gold Project. Drill and blast contractor, Total Drilling Services Pty Ltd, commenced a 6 month program with initial focus over the months of January & February 2012. This follows grade control drilling recently completed in December 2011 (1,647 metres, results pending) which infilled the drilling completed in 2002. Nex anticipates the new grade control drilling will increase the available tonnes as data gaps in the orebody are defined. Trucking contractor Calin Haulage Pty Ltd is on site and preparing existing gold ore stockpiles for transportation to A1 Minerals Limited's Brightstar Mill for toll treating. Nex has an initial 6 month campaign to treat 158,281 tonnes averaging 2.67g/t Au for an expected 13,600 recovered ounces. Initial production at the Brightstar Mill is expected in the last week of January or the first week of February. This arrangement supplements the toll treating agreement with Navigator Resources Ltd.
